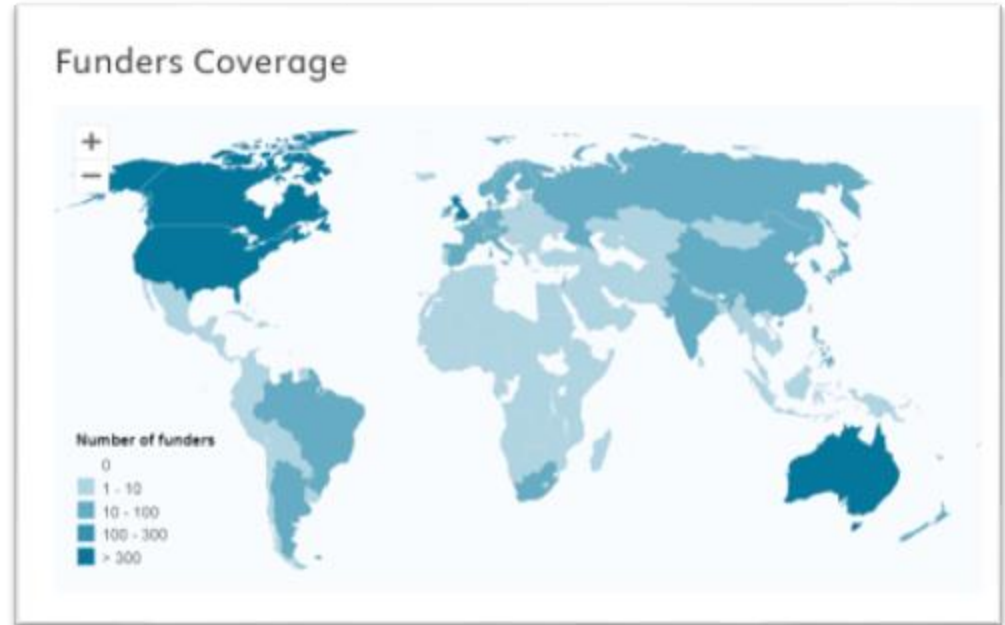

Understanding the data

Funding Institutional includes:

- **40k active and recurring** funding opportunities
- **+9M** awarded grants, going back to 1954, linked with Scopus Author profiles and resulting publications
- From **+16k** funders globally including government, foundation, charity, academic organization



Content selection principles & due diligence

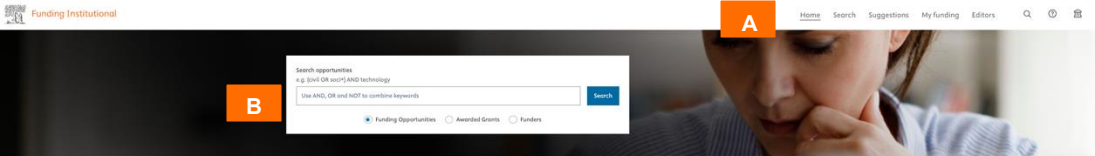
- Scope of our coverage: **fundings must support R&D related activities**.
- Funding Institutional's due diligence consists of three main principles:
 - **Findable data;**
 - **Quality data;**
 - **Reliable data updates.**
- There are two ways of adding funders to the database:
 - **Screening of the funder landscape in focus geographies;**
 - **Customers' recommendations.**
- Each new funder, that we discover must meet the minimal criteria to include their funding information in the database.

Minimal criteria to include funding information in FI

- Funding information needs to be openly available online.
- Be relevant to and readable by international audiences:
 - data sets and information should be available in Roman script (or a substantial portion should be translated into a language with Roman script), and
 - the award title and description should be available in English.
 - Exceptions can be and are made, for example: the National Natural Science Foundation of China awards (all in Chinese) and Japan Society for the Promotion of Science awards (a mix of English and Japanese), etc.
- Information available online needs to be maintained with regular update cycles (at least once a year).

Required & enriched data fields for opportunities

- Title and/or description (preferably in English) - **one of them is mandatory**
- Opportunity URL - **mandatory**
- Link to application instructions and/ or application address - **mandatory**
- Funding type (research grant, individual fellowship, etc.)
- Applicant eligibility criteria, incl. limited submission
- Application due dates
- Funded research area(s)
- Expected funding amount
- Unique call for application, identifier at funder



Home page overview

A. The top menu includes access to advanced **Search**, **Suggestions** and **My funding**, a library of saved searches, opportunities tracked and sent to Pure. The **Editors** functions are visible, for editors and admins.

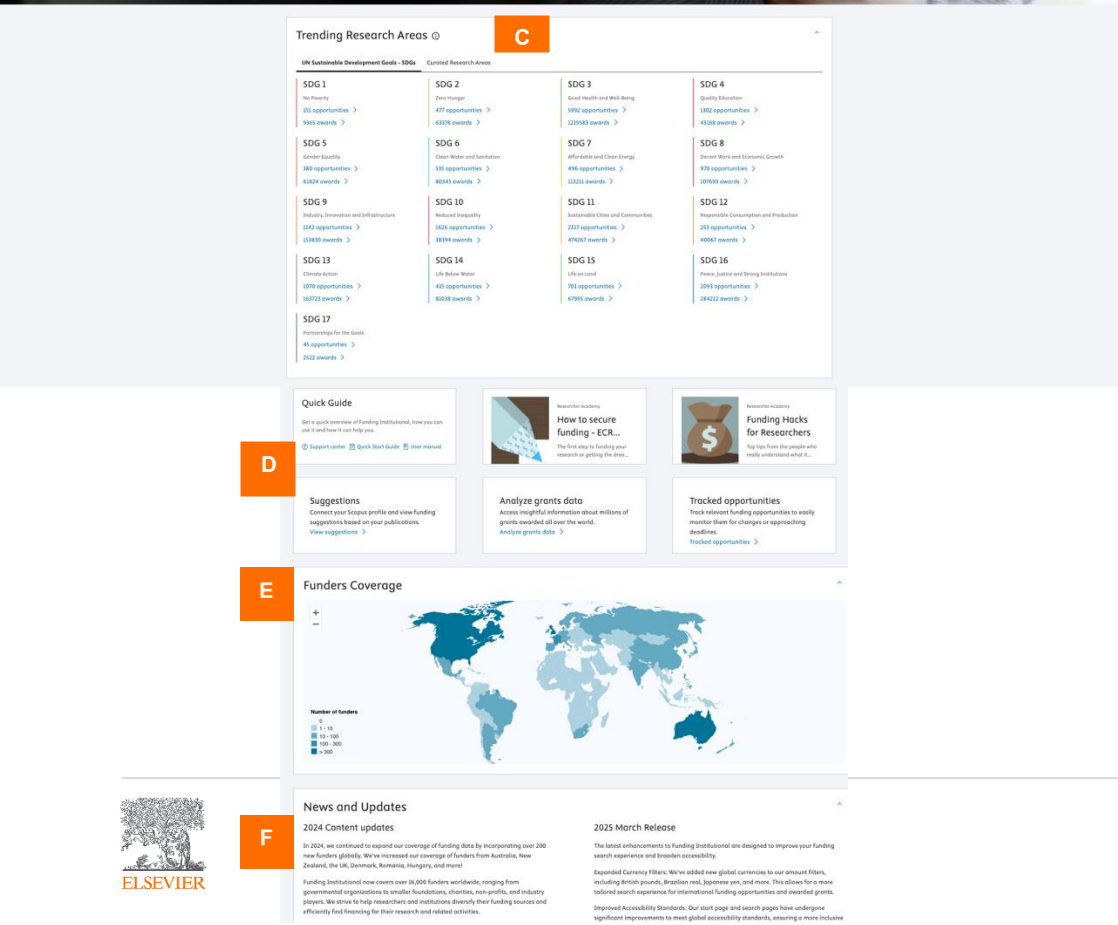
The **magnifying glass** icon allows you to access the search from any page. The **question mark** icon provides access to the support resources. The **Institution** icon displays the institution with which the user's login is affiliated. The **Profile** (name initials) icon provides access to **Account** details, including the ability to change your login credentials and e-mail address, as well as **Roles**, through which admins can create or modify their user's permissions settings.

B. **Search** provides basic search of opportunities, awards and funders by selecting the respective radio button.

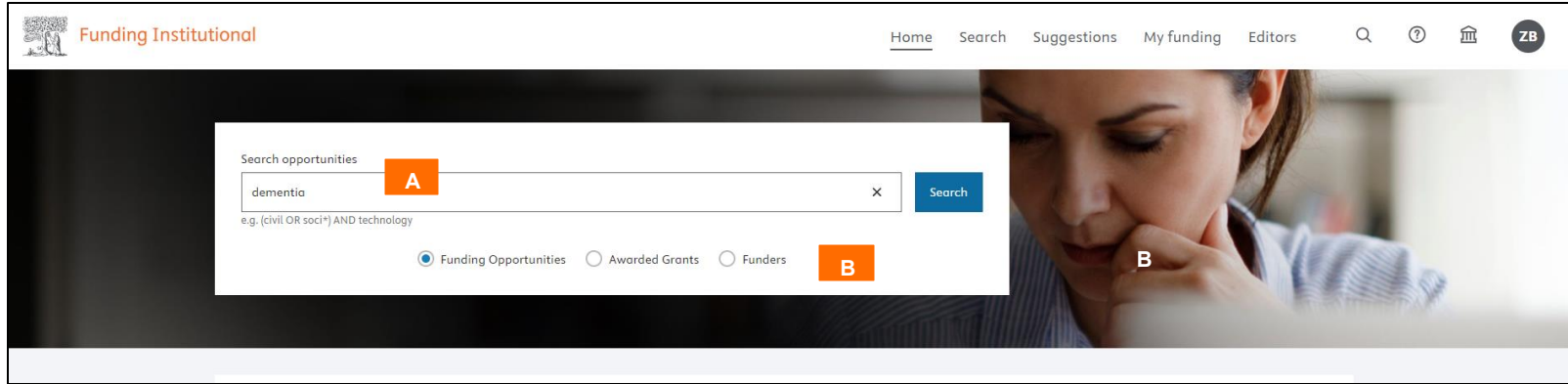
D. Shortcuts include user guidance and support, funding related Researcher Academy training sessions, funding suggestions based on Scopus profiles section, the Awarded grants database and tracked opportunities.

E. The **global map** indicates the geographical distribution of funders covered over the world. Hover over the countries for more details and click to see the full list of funders covered in the country of interest.

F. News and updates section on content expansion and feature releases.

Search

A. Provide a basic search term. The search engine will find data including the search term or terms. When no Boolean operator is used in a search with multiple keywords, an OR operator will be used in the search logic. All the keywords entered in the basic search may be potentially found. The round brackets and the Boolean operators AND, OR and NOT in capital letters can also be used in the basic search.

B. Select the respective data type by clicking on the radio button/tab respective to **Opportunities**, **Awards** and **Funders**.

Keyword search

- When **no Boolean operator** is used in a search with multiple keywords, an **OR** operator will be used in the search logic
- In these cases, we will show results where either of the listed keywords appear

Keyword search

- If you need two keywords to appear next to each other, you need to use the “**double quotation marks**”
- Using double quotation marks will still allow for stemming of words and picking up plural versions of words

A. Enter keywords in the **All of these words** field. Each keyword must be in the results.

B. Enter keywords in the **Any of these words** field. At least one of these words must be included in the search. Note that this is the same search as the basic search option.

C. Enter keywords in the **None of these words** field. Here, the keywords are excluded, and they must not appear.

D. Enter keywords in the **Prioritized words** field. The search results with these words will be prioritized and appear at top of the results list. The number of results doesn't change, but the order does according to the prioritized words.

Field codes

- Using **no field codes** mean that you **search in all data fields** of opportunities and awarded grants
- **Opportunities field codes** enable searches in opportunity titles, description and eligibility descriptions
- **Awarded grants field codes** enable searches in the award titles, description and awardee first- and surname
- You need to use **field codes all in capitals** and with (round brackets) around the keyword, for example **ELIG(phd)**
- Field codes **can be combined** using the Boolean operators, for example **SURNAME(smith) AND GIVEN(john)** or **ELIG(postdoc OR postdoctoral)**

- By applying the **applicant affiliation filter**, users will see opportunities that either restrict applicants to those being affiliated with an institute at a specific location or explicitly state in the opportunity description that applicants of any location are welcome to apply.
- The **activity country filter** will display opportunities that specify the location where the research or related activity is to be conducted.

Search tips

- The basic search includes Boolean Operators in capital letters: AND, OR and NOT and round brackets.
- The wildcard (*) finds multiple words entering a few characters.
- Using the singular form of a word in your search finds both the singular and plural forms for most words.

For example, heart attack finds results listing heart attack and heart attacks.

- To find documents where your search terms appear together, enclose your phrase in double quotes.

For example, “stem cell” returns documents with both stem and cell. Without double quotes, *stem cell* returns documents with the words either *stem* or *cell* or *stem* and *cell* throughout the document and not necessarily together.

Find funding related to Global Challenges

- Funding Institutional offers **predefined search queries** to assist you in finding funding opportunities and awarded grants related to specific research themes

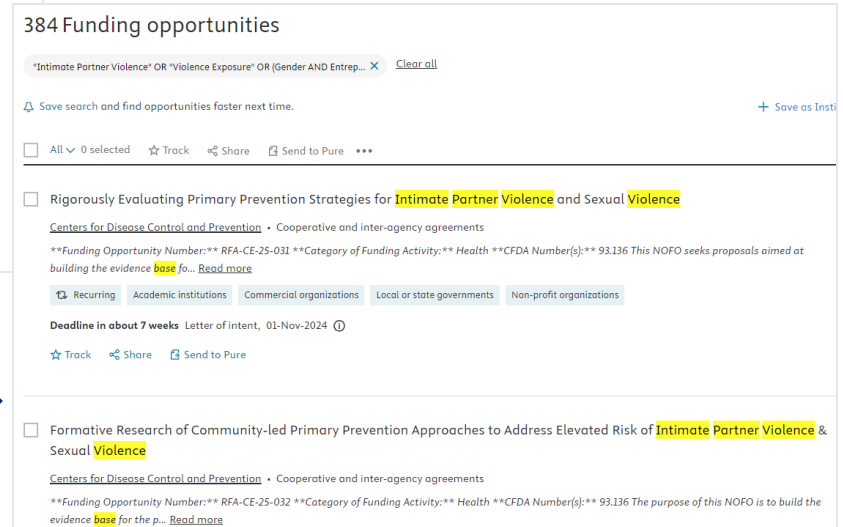

Common Search Pitfalls

- Boolean operators need to be used **all in capitals**
- When **no Boolean operator** is used in a search with multiple keywords, an **OR** operator will be used in the search logic, for example brain cancer is equivalent to brain OR cancer. Same applies to field code searches TITLE(brain cancer) is equivalent to TITLE(brain OR cancer), which will return results with either brain or cancer in the title.
- **Using no field codes mean that you search in all data fields of opportunities and awarded grants**
- Field codes need to be used **all in capitals**

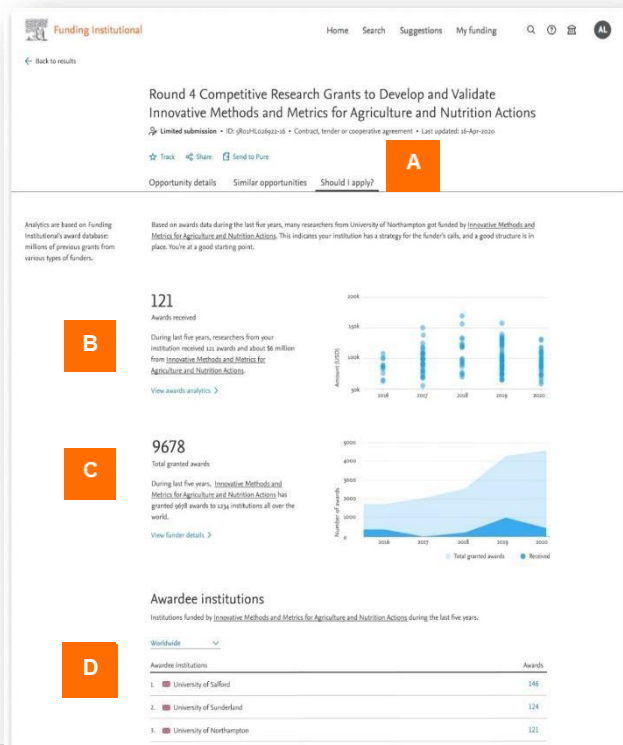

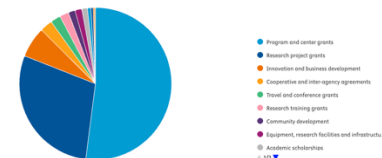

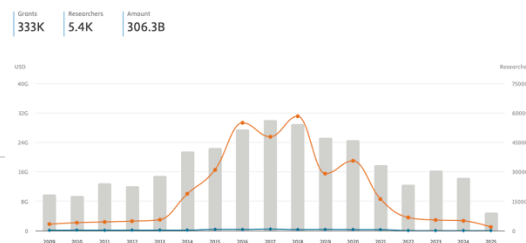
